

Train and Logging Truck Collision

Location: Naver Creek Road (North of Quesnel)

Date of Incident: June 10, 2020

Details of Incident: An Eastbound loaded logging truck was crossing a marked rail crossing when a southbound freight train collided with the trailer. The truck and trailer flipped onto its side spilling the logs into the ditch.

Recommended Preventative Actions:

- Avoid complacency
- Expect the unexpected
- Never attempt to beat the train at a crossing
- When approaching a railroad crossing, slow down, look both ways, and listen for a train on the tracks
- Never stop on railroad tracks. Keep moving once you have entered the crossing
- Reduce the risk of stalling by not shifting gears on the tracks.
